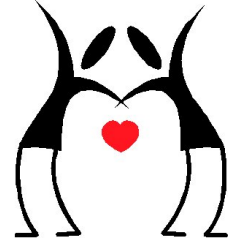


Regional Crime Victim Crisis Center

Advise stalking victims:

- You can be pro-active...even if you are told there is nothing the police can do.
- Keep a log. Write down every incident, date, time and place. This will help build a case.
- Request that the police officer file a report of each incident that you call about.

- Call RCVCC during business hours for help and support. 677-7895
- Call 911 if you feel you are in immediate danger.
- Call Sgt. Lynn Beard at the Abilene Police Department, 673-8331, to see if your case is being investigated as a stalking.
